



In last week's newsletter I mentioned a times table programme we have bought into called, TT Rock Stars. It has already proved to be very popular with the children, your child (from Year 2 to Year 6) should have received a log in to enable them to access the programme.

We have recently added some curriculum information to the different year group pages on the website. For each year group there is now a summary document which details the National Curriculum expectations for all subjects.

Could I just remind parents/carers how important it is for children to arrive at school on time. The gates open at 8.40 a.m. and the bell then goes at 8.50, which is when children should be entering the building, so that learning can start at 8.55. As I know you will appreciate the beginning of the day is an extremely important time for your child. When late, a child misses important information and also has the embarrassment of walking into a class that has already started work. During the last half term many children were arriving late for school, and a few children are regularly late. Your support and co-operation on this matter is vital. The gates around the school will now be shut at 9.05 am; this is to ensure the safety of the children.
